1. Who We Are

Langovest Ltd ("Langovest", "we", "us", or "our") is an African infrastructure development company registered in Nigeria (RC8727083). We originate, structure, and develop modular infrastructure projects across water, food security, connectivity, education, and healthcare sectors across the African continent.

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store, and protect personal information gathered through our website at langovest.com and any related communications. It applies to website visitors, interest register submissions, partner enquiries, event registrations, and any other interactions with our website or team.

2. Information We Collect

Information you provide directly:

- Interest register form: full name, email address, investor or partner type, and any optional message you include
- Partner or sponsor enquiries: name, organisation, email address, and the nature of your enquiry
- Event registrations: name, email address, organisation, and role
- General contact: any information you include when contacting us at hello@langovest.com or any published Langovest email address

Information collected automatically:

- Device and browser data: IP address, browser type, operating system, and device identifiers
- Usage data: pages visited, time spent on pages, links clicked, and navigation patterns
- Cookies: we use essential cookies for basic website functionality and analytics cookies to understand how our site is used. See Section 8 for more detail.

3. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect to:

- Respond to enquiries, contact form submissions, and interest register registrations
- Contact you when our investment structure or partnership opportunities are formally established, if you have registered your interest
- Send event confirmations, updates, and post-event materials
- Understand how our website is used so we can improve it
- Comply with legal obligations under Nigerian law

We do not use your information for automated decision-making or profiling. We do not use your information to send unsolicited commercial communications from third parties.

4. Legal Basis for Processing

We process your personal information on the following legal bases:

- Consent: where you have actively submitted a form or registered your interest
- Legitimate interests: to operate and improve our website, respond to enquiries, and conduct our business activities
- Legal obligation: where we are required to retain or share information under Nigerian law, including the Nigeria Data Protection Act 2023 and the Nigeria Data Protection Regulation (NDPR)

5. Information Sharing

We do not sell your personal information. We do not share your information with third parties for their own marketing purposes.

We may share information in the following limited circumstances:

- Service providers: third-party vendors who support our website operations (hosting, analytics, email delivery). These providers process data only on our behalf and under our instructions.
- Legal requirements: where required by Nigerian law, court order, or regulatory authority
- Business transfers: in the event of a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, personal information may be transferred to the successor entity

9. Data Retention

We retain personal information for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected, or as required by Nigerian law. Interest register submissions are retained until the Langovest investment structure is formally established and the relevant contact has been made, or until you request deletion. Analytics data is retained in aggregate form.

10. Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your personal information against unauthorised access, loss, or disclosure, consistent with our obligations under the Nigeria Data Protection Regulation (NDPR). No system is completely secure. We commit to protecting your information using industry-standard practices and to notifying you promptly in the event of a material data breach.

Langovest Ltd is a Nigerian-registered company and processes personal data in accordance with the Nigeria Data Protection Regulation (NDPR) issued by the National Information Technology Development Agency (NITDA) and the Nigeria Data Protection Act 2023. Our data processing practices are designed to meet the requirements of these frameworks.

If you access our website from outside Nigeria, your information may be processed in Nigeria and in the countries where our service providers operate. We ensure that appropriate safeguards are in place for any international transfers of personal data, consistent with the NDPR and applicable Nigerian law.
